1) **Location/Date:** DCC Cluster Concert at Blair High School – Oct. 17, 2017 Blair High School – 51 University Blvd., East; Silver Spring, MD 20901

2) Call Times:

Tuesday October 17: Chorus students need to arrive at BLAIR HS by 6:00pm Concert begins at 7:00pm

If at all possible, students should arrive no later than 6:00pm. We will line up, warm up, and review concert etiquette and procedures. The concert starts at 7:00pm. We will be finished by approximately 8:30pm. Parents, we hope you'll be joining us, but if you will not be attending the concert, please arrange for your student's ride to be at the school by 8:25pm.

- 3) Concert attire: We will be wearing our uniform shirts and black pants for this concert, as mentioned in the handbook at the beginning of the year. All students need to wear his/her EMS Chorus shirt, and black pants (no denim or navy blue please). Ladies may wear a floor/ankle length black skirt if they so choose. Also, black dress shoes (and socks as appropriate) should be worn. If you do not own the above clothing, try to find or borrow it for the concert. To answer the question "Is something an alternative substitute?" If I will notice the difference, it's probably not acceptable.
